Dear BTC Members,

Yesterday the BC Government announced new measures to help slow the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19). While both the Public Health Agency of Canada and Vancouver Coastal Health have assessed the risk to residents of British Columbia as **low**, the health and safety of the BTC community remains our top priority. We will continue to monitor the situation and will take necessary steps to keep our members and staff safe as conditions change and we will communicate any new developments. Decisions will be guided by the expert medical advice of local health authorities.

New measures for all Members, Staff, and Guests

- Members, guests or staff who are returning from anywhere outside of Canada are asked to stay away from the Club for 14 days upon arrival.
- Members, guests or staff who have been in close contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 are asked to stay home for 14 days after their last encounter.
- If you have had any fever, shortness of breath, cough, or sore throat within the last 14 days, you are asked to stay away from the Club and seek medical attention.
- Members please remember you are responsible for your guests so if your guests meet the above conditions please do not come to the club.
- If a child arrives for a lesson or program with any symptoms of fever, cough, shortness of breath or sore throat, the parents/guardians will be asked to take the child home.
- Avoid touching ie. handshakes and properly wash your hands right after playing.

Increased Cleaning of common areas 2 times a day with hospital grade disinfectant including:

- All clubhouse doors and handles
- All washrooms, faucets, counters, changing benches
- Kitchen faucets, fridge water dispenser and doors
- Office door, handles, counters and credit card machine
- Bubble doors, key pad and handles
